WALL HANGING AND PRINTED LINEN PANEL GLOSSARY	
PLP	<i>Printed Linen Panel</i> refers to designs that ordered as lengths of printed fabric to be made up to your own specification. (cf. Wall hanging below.)
WH	<i>Wall Hanging</i> refers to a finished product that is ready to be installed; it is lined and interlined, weighted and fitted with a Velcro strip along the top edge.
BF/BWH	<i>Bespoke Fabric/Bespoke Wall Hanging</i> refers to designs that have been adapted, printed and, in the case of WH's, made-up to a client's specification.
PA	<i>Print Allowances</i> refer to printed seaming allowance in both the vertical and in the lateral dimensions.
SA	The <i>Seaming Allowance</i> refers to the PA on the sides of each drop – usually 1-2 cm on each side. In some cases, the SA on the external edges of the first and last drops will be wider to provide some additional tolerance.
VPA	The <i>Vertical Print Allowance</i> is the PA at the top and bottom of each drop. This will usually be a total of 20 cm split equally top & bottom; for Bespoke orders it may vary and will be agreed during the specification for the job.
MB	<i>Mirror Bleed</i> is a specific type of PA created by mirroring the outer sections of a design.
TPD (Design)	The <i>Total Print Dimensions (Design)</i> are the dimensions of the whole design including the <i>Print Allowances</i> on the external edges.
NPD (Design)	The <i>Net Print Dimensions (Design)</i> are the dimensions of the whole design net of any <i>Print Allowances</i> .
TPD (Drop)	The <i>Total Print Dimensions (Drop)</i> are the dimensions of a drop of fabric including the <i>Print Allowances</i> .
NPD (Drop)	The <i>Net Print Dimensions (Drop)</i> are the dimensions of a drop of fabric net of any <i>Print Allowances</i> .
